

# FABRIC ISLAND DRESSING

# HIGHLY PERMEABLE WITH GOOD ADHESIVE STRENGTH

Medstock Fabric Island Dressing is made of a spunlace, non-woven fabric coating with a specialised medical-grade acrylic adhesive and an absorbent fabric pad.

### **Key Functions and Features**

- Creates an occlusive environment, whilst being absorbent and permeable to oxygen and moisture
- + Hypoallergenic
- + Mild peeling strength
- + Does not roll up or fall off skin
- Prevents bacterial invasion and accelerates wound healing


### **General Advice on Safe Use**

- Ensure wound area is clean and dry before application
- Dressing pad should overlap the wound by at least 2cm onto the dry surrounding skin
- Can be left in place for up to 5 days depending on exudate level and type of wound
- Can be used as a secondary dressing over hydrocolloid paste, alginate and other primary dressings



### **Indications for Use**

- Suitable for wounds with nil to mild exudate
- + Grazes, abrasions and superficial burns
- + Surgical wounds



First Layer: Spunlace non-woven

Second Layer: Medical grade PSA

Third Layer: Cotton island pad absorption rate is ≥ 5 times the original pad weight

**Backing Release Paper**: Glassine release liner



### **Contraindications / Precautions**

- Seek medical advice immediately for all serious wounds and burns
- If reddening or sensitisation occurs, discontinue use and consult a physician

## Period of Validity

The product shall be valid for 5 years from the sterilisation date, provided that it is kept under the stipulated storage conditions

### **Storage Conditions**

Store in a well-ventilated clean room at or below 35°C with relative humidity less than 80% and no corrosive gas

### **Packaging**

 Each dressing is packaged in a paper/poly closed pouch, then packed into our unique colour coded Medstock boxes
